IEC PRIDE PAC Champion of the Year Award

The IEC PRIDE PAC Champion of the Year is the IEC member or chapter staffer that raises the most money for PRIDE PAC

- For 2021, the award will take into account the total amount of funds raised between January 1, 2021 and September 6, 2021 (one month before convention).
- For 2022, the award will take into account the total amount of funds raised between September 7, 2022 and one month before convention.
- For contributions to be counted, the donor **must** list the member to be credited with the contribution to either in the online or hard copy form. To simplify and limit staff's time spent tracking, if the contributor fails to include the name of the IEC member who recruited their donation, it will not count.
- Must raise a minimum of \$2,000. If no member raises \$2,000 or more, then no award will be given.
- A member's own contribution to the PAC will count, up to \$500. For example, an IEC Member contributes \$1,000 of their own money to the PAC, that member must still raise \$1,500 from other members to receive consideration.
- Donations to PRIDE PAC must come in the form of a personal contribution and from IEC members.
- Must be an IEC member or staff person of an IEC chapter to be eligible.

Award

- The PRIDE PAC Champion of the Year will receive:
 - Recognition during the IEC National Convention.
 - Complimentary admission to the National Convention. This can be transferred to another member.
 - A \$300 Home Depot gift card.
 - Free admission to other advocacy related Convention events.
