

IEC National 2027 Executive Committee Nominee Information

Qualifications

Members interested in serving on the IEC National Executive Committee should meet the following qualifications according to the IEC National Bylaws:

- Be a contractor presently engaged in the business of electrical construction, maintenance, or repair.
- Be an active IEC contractor member.
- Have served at least one year on the IEC National Board of Directors.

Involvement

Members interested in serving should be able to:

- Demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the association, its history, vision, and the members we serve.
- Stay current with both national and local issues that affect the association, industry and our members.
- Act on issues in accord with what is best for the entire association, regardless of chapter or regional affiliation.
- Attend Executive Committee and Board of Directors Meetings (virtual and in-person):
 - Conference Calls
 - Business Summit
 - Policy Conference
 - SPARK
 - Board Retreat
 - Chapter and regional activities

Expenses

The Executive Committee members are eligible for reimbursement, within the guidelines provided by the IEC Travel Reimbursement Policy, for travel on behalf of IEC and as part of their responsibilities as officers of the association. Executive Committee members are not required to pay registration fees to Business Summit, Policy Conference, and SPARK, however, their spouses and/or guests must register and pay the required event fee, if attending.

Process

Interested members must have a nomination form submitted on their behalf via the [online form](#) no later than June 5, 2026. The IEC National Nominating Committee will review all submissions and may request additional information or conduct interviews to determine the most qualified candidates.

The election for vacant Executive Committee seats will take place at the House of Delegates Meeting at SPARK on October 23, 2026 in Columbus, Ohio. The 2027 term will begin January 1, 2027.
